We Care for Kids Pledge \$1 Million

Windsor Essex Care for Kids Foundation (WECK) has made a \$1 million dollar pledge toward the project that will be a first in the region and will improve Paediatric care for Windsor and Essex County. The new Paediatric O.R. will cut wait times by at least half and provide more operating room time, which in turn will encourage more Paediatric surgeons to the area. Since 1997, WECK has raised over \$2.8 million dollars, with 2007 being a record year for the Campaign, raising a total of \$398,000. Over the last 11 years, many projects have been funded including a Playroom in Paediatric Services at Windsor Regional Hospital.
