Ouellette Upgrade

#### Department

Renovations to address long-standing issues in the Emergency Department at the Ouellette Campus have been completed, with several key changes that improve patient comfort and efficiency. The most noticeable change was to the Triage Registration area.

Emergency

There is now a parallel triage-registration area where patient information is completed in the same area, eliminating extra steps previously in place.

"The changes create an overall better ER experience for the patient, improving safety and reducing wait times," said Dr. Donald Levy, Chief of Emergency Medicine at the Ouellette ER.

Another key change is the addition of a second Rapid Medical Evaluation (RME) exam area, a pilot that began in 2011, assisting with lower wait times and increasing patient satisfaction for patients whose condition requires a quick review or can be dealt with rapidly.
