The Flu Fight Continues

Although our vaccination statistics are better this year than last year, they are still not where we want them to be for a healthcare facility, especially with the influenza season beginning to ramp up. In order to provide our staff and their families with the most opportunities to fight the flu this season, the WE CARE pharmacy will be holding Family and Friends Flu Fighter Vaccination Clinics on Wednesday, November 12, from 5-8 pm and on Saturday, November 15, from 10 am -3 pm at the Ouellette campus. Bring your whole family, invite your neighbours, relatives, and friends, and come get vaccinated. There will be pizza and a number of activities for the kids to enjoy. All Windsor Regional Hospital team members are invited, regardless of the campus you work at.

Just a reminder that the WE CARE Pharmacy is open and giving flu vaccinations on a drop-in basis, Monday through Friday, from 9am to 5pm. And for those employees at the Met Campus, the IDA Pharmacy located at the corner of Tecumseh and Kildare (in the parking lot) is also providing flu shots – again, please call to confirm hours and availability (519-977-0090).

As well, we have only received approximately 1300 consent/decline forms thus far. All hospital staff and physicians are asked to complete it (choose one of the four options – Yes I consent to be immunized; Yes I have been immunized elsewhere; No I am medically exempt; No I decline immunization) and submit this form to the Employee Health Office. This form can be downloaded from the Employee Health Intranet webpage and is also available in the Employee Health Office and We Care Pharmacy. The information collected on this form is used to report the statistics for our organization to the Windsor-Essex County Public Health Unit, as required by the Ministry of Health. If you have been immunized elsewhere or are medically exempt from receiving the flu vaccine, please submit your documentation to the Employee Health Office with your completed consent/decline form.

We want to not only protect you but your entire family as well. Become a flu fighting family by getting your flu shot and help us beat the flu this year!

Carrot Soup with Orange and Ginger

Makes 4 Servings / Preparation: 15 minutes

INGREDIENTS

- 1 Tbsp. extra virgin olive oil
- 4 cups chopped carrots, peeled, cut into 1/2-inch pieces
- 1 cup chopped yellow onions
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 4 large strips orange zest
- 3 cups low-sodium chicken broth (type of broth optional)
- 1 tsp. finely minced fresh ginger
- 1/2 cup orange juice
- 1 Tbsp. fresh lemon juice, optional
- Salt and ground black pepper to taste
- 1/4 cup chopped chives (dill may be substituted)

In large pot, heat oil over medium-high heat and add carrots and onions. Sauté about 7-8 minutes. Add garlic and sauté additional 2 minutes. Add broth and orange zest strips. Cover and bring to a boil. Reduce heat, uncover and simmer until carrots are tender, about 10-12 minutes. Let mixture cool for several minutes. Discard orange zest strips. Working in batches, in food processor or blender, purée mixture until velvety smooth. Return soup to pot. Stir in ginger and orange and lemon juices. Season with salt and pepper to taste. Over low heat, let soup simmer for 5 minutes for flavors to mingle. Garnish with chives and serve.
