The second phase of the successful "2 by 4" initiative that highlights two major safety initiatives is about to begin, with new opportunities to educate patients upon admission and new quizzes and prizes for staff!

The 2 by 4 campaign was launched last fall, with a public campaign and an education blitz held at both campuses. The "2" represents the "2 patient identifier" safety protocol and the "4" represents the four moments of hand hygiene – required organizational practices and vital safety initiatives that protect our patients.

In order to reinforce the "2 by 4" message, the second phase of the campaign next week will give patients more information at the time of admission. Admitting staff at both campuses will wear "2 by 4" t-shirts and encourage patient engagement with "ASK ME!" buttons to help patients understand why WRH places such importance on patient identification measures and proper hand hygiene

Tangy Beef Stew

Makes: 10 servings
Prep time: 10 min
Cook time: 90 min



Ingredients

- 1/4 cup (50mL) all-purpose flour
- 1/4 tsp (1 mL) pepper
- 2 lb (1 kg) stewing beef, cut into cubes
- 1 cup (250 mL) water
- 1/4 cup (50 mL) brown sugar
- 1 tbsp (15 mL) Worcestershire sauce
- 1/2 green pepper, cut in strips
- 3 potatoes, cubed
- 1 tbsp (15 mL) canola oil
- 1/2 cup (125 mL) ketchup
- 1/4 cup (50 mL) vinegar
- 1 large onion, chopped
- 3 carrots, sliced

Preparation

In bowl, combine flour and pepper. Coat beef with flour mixture. In large skillet, heat canola oil and brown meat on all sides. In another bowl, combine water, ketchup, brown sugar, vinegar and Worcestershire sauce. Stir into browned meat. Add onion; cover. Cook over low heat for 45 minutes, stirring occasionally. Add remaining vegetables. Cook until meat and vegetables are tender, approximately 45 minutes.
