Most Canadians who access health services receive safe care. However, sometimes there are adverse effects to receiving care — unintended harm associated with the delivery of care that can result in a prolonged hospital stay, disability or death. For the fourth time in 2018, Windsor Regional Hospital has achieved a "0" Harm Index. A Zero Harm index measures a number of preventable harms that occur in hospitals such as falls, health-acquired infections and irreplaceable lab specimens.

This remarkable achievement occurred again in May 2018 at the Met Campus. All those involved in patient care at every level should be proud of this achievement.

## #RECIPEOFTHEWEEK

#### **Rhubarb Crisp**

Makes 6-8 servings Preparation: 15 min Cooking Time: 75 min

#### Ingredients

- 1 cup large-flake oats
- 3/4 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/2 cup packed brown sugar
- 3/4 tsp salt
- 1/2 cup cold unsalted butter, cubed

- 6 cups chopped rhubarb, cut into 1-inch pieces (about 760 g)
- 1 cup granulated sugar
- 1/3 cup cornstarch
- 2 tbsp water

#### **Directions**

POSITION rack in lower third of oven and preheat to 350F.

TOPPING: Stir oats, flour, brown sugar and salt in a bowl. Add butter and work in, using your fingertips, until crumbly. Refrigerate until ready to use.

FILLING: Toss rhubarb, sugar, cornstarch and water in a large bowl, stirring until cornstarch is absorbed. Let sit 5 min and stir again. Transfer to a 9 x 13-in. glass baking dish.

SPRINKLE oat mixture evenly over rhubarb. Bake in lower third of oven until top is golden and juices are bubbling around edges and through the top of crisp, about 1 hour. Let cool completely. Serve with ice cream.

When a patient is transferred - leave the Additional Precautions sign up for housekeeping, and ensure a new sign is hung in the new room.

When a patient is discharged – leave the sign up for housekeeping – this may change how they treat the space and also allows them to follow the proper PPE during cleaning
