### **ED Conference A Big Success**

The City of Roses 6th Annual Community Emergency Medicine Conference was held on November 15th at a packed Ciociaro Club and was a great opportunity for learning and networking about best practices in emergency care.

The event, which is now the third largest Emergency Medicine conference in the country, gathered some 600 delegates from Windsor-Essex and many other communities who were treated to some 18 presentations on a wide ranging list of topics.

Among the discussions were presentations regarding many current topics in the media such as fentanyl and crystal meth, as well as the potential medical implications of recreational cannabis use. There were also clinical discussions about dental emergencies, oncology cases, Lyme disease, bariatric surgery, burn management, injury trends, orthopaedics and paediatric toxicology. Also discussed was the importance of providing great patient satisfaction alongside quality care, and "recognizing burnout" among health care providers.

Thank you to keynote speaker Dr. David Carr, University Health Network, for his illuminating presentations on endocarditis and diagnosis of aortic dissection, and of course to Dr. Snez Ninkovich for her amazing efforts in organizing this incredible conference for medical professionals, students and health sector personnel!
