Tour Enlightens Kids About Future Health Care Careers

An annual event hosted by the Human Resources Department of Windsor Regional Hospital is 'Take Your Kid To Work Day', held last week at the Met Campus. Grade 9 students qualify and parents of students who work at WRH are permitted to accompany their child on the tour.

After a welcome and overview of the hospital, students took part in social activities as a warm-up. Then they had the opportunity to tour departments throughout the day that included Diagnostic Imaging, Operating Room, MDRD, Pharmacy, Biomedical Engineering, Cancer Centre, SOP Mapping, Radiation Therapy, Physio and Occupational Therapy and the Family Birthing Centre.

The interactive tour gave students a general overview on how a hospital operates within departments and the debriefing session provided students opportunities to ask questions related to their interest in a future healthcare career.

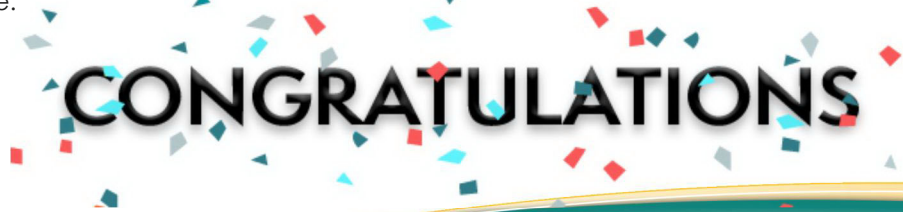

ED Conference A Big Success

The City of Roses 6th Annual Community Emergency Medicine Conference was held on November 15th at a packed Ciociaro Club and was a great opportunity for learning and networking about best practices in emergency care.

The event, which is now the third largest Emergency Medicine conference in the country, gathered some 600 delegates from Windsor-Essex and many other communities who were treated to some 18 presentations on a wide ranging list of topics.

Among the discussions were presentations regarding many current topics in the media such as fentanyl and crystal meth, as well as the potential medical implications of recreational cannabis use. There were also clinical discussions about dental emergencies, oncology cases, Lyme disease, bariatric surgery, burn management, injury trends, orthopaedics and paediatric toxicology. Also discussed was the importance of providing great patient satisfaction alongside quality care, and "recognizing burnout" among health care providers.

Thank you to keynote speaker Dr. David Carr, University Health Network, for his illuminating presentations on endocarditis and diagnosis of aortic dissection, and of course to Dr. Snez Ninkovich for her amazing efforts in organizing this incredible conference for medical professionals, students and health sector personnel!
