



### **Baked Apple Chips**

Makes 8 servings Preparation: 10 min Cooking Time: 60 min

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 4 large apples (any variety)
- 2 tsp cinnamon
- 1Tbsp granulated sugar

#### DIRECTIONS



Slice apples horizontally into very thin rounds, using a sharp knife or mandolin (remove any seeds that do not fall out as you cut). Lay the slices in a sinale layer on parchment paper, and sprinkle lightly with the cinnamon sugar (combined). Bake at 250 degrees for 1 hour, flip slices, and bake for an additional hour (2 hours total). Chips will continue to crisp up as they cool.

\*Tip: Don't peel your apples! The peel contains a third or more of its cancer-fighting phytochemical compounds.
