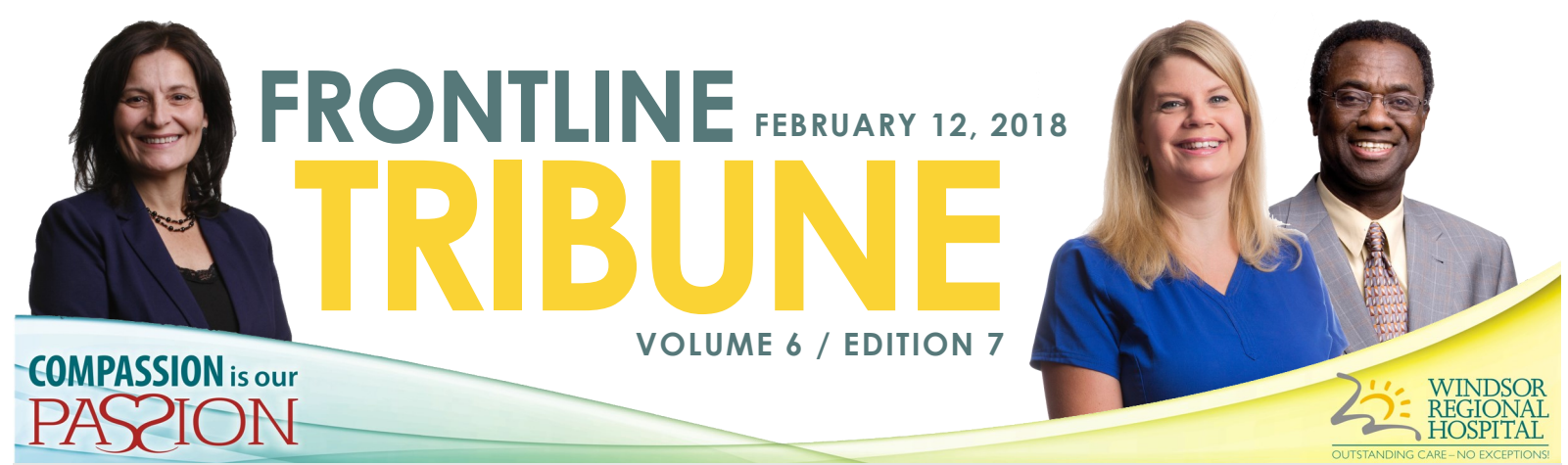

The Fight Like Mason Foundation was established as a non-profit organization by Iain and Chantelle Macri, parents of Mason Bacon-Macri. Mason's story is well known as he became a Superhero himself when he fought the dreaded disease of cancer. He was diagnosed in 2015 at age 2 with Rhabdomyosarcoma, a rare and challenging form of the disease. Mason, as young as he was, fought hard to overcome the day to day affects of cancer. He passed at 4, however, he left a lasting impression on the world! When he was at home, he had use of an IV pole and other medical devices to assist his care.

The Fight Like Mason Foundation offers professional medical IV poles that are manufactured with superhero and other animated characters affixed to them. The devices are appropriately named, Mason's Power Poles.

The Foundation plans to donate a number of the IV poles to Paediatric Services in the future. Their mission is to improve treatment, care, quality of life and awareness of patients diagnosed with childhood rhabdomyosarcoma and other paediatric cancers.

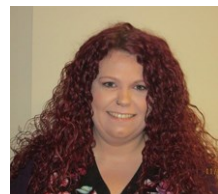

Recipe of the Week

Baked Apple Chips

Makes 8 servings
Preparation: 10 min
Cooking Time: 60 min



INGREDIENTS

- 4 large apples (any variety)
- 2 tsp cinnamon
- 1Tbsp granulated sugar

DIRECTIONS

Slice apples horizontally into very thin rounds, using a sharp knife or mandolin (remove any seeds that do not fall out as you cut). Lay the slices in a single layer on parchment paper, and sprinkle lightly with the cinnamon sugar (combined). Bake at 250 degrees for 1 hour, flip slices, and bake for an additional hour (2 hours total). Chips will continue to crisp up as they cool.

*Tip: Don't peel your apples! The peel contains a third or more of its cancer-fighting phytochemical compounds.
