Registered For Organ Donation? Have Lunch On Us

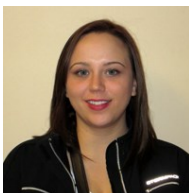
Windsor Regional Hospital is proud to support the efforts by the Trillium Gift of Life Network to raise awareness about the importance of organ and tissue donation and the many lives that can be saved and improved through transplants.

In Windsor, we've reached the quarter-way mark – with registrations as of the end of March 2016 at 25% of health card carrying individuals in the city, an increase of 4,200 registrants from a year earlier. That's still below the provincial average of 29%. In order to encourage staff to register, WRH is offering a pizza lunch for those who register – or can confirm they are already registered – on Friday, April 15th (Ouellette) and Friday, April 29th (Met) between 11:30 am and 1 pm.

All you have to do is bring your health card to prove you are registered – or use it to sign up with our laptop at the organ donation display (in the cafeteria at Ouellette and the vendor hallway at Met).

1,000 Items Collected For Street Help

Thank you to everyone at WRH who took the time to donate food and personal hygiene products to the "Spring Forward for Street Help" drive last month!

The many donations will help Street Help, a leading local provider of services to Windsor's homeless population, with their "Dinner to Go" program whereby a comfort pack of food for the homeless to snack on is provided after the 964 Wyandotte St. East homeless centre closes each day.

The food items also help Street Help feed clients for breakfast, lunch and dinner, 365 days a year.

The drive was started by WRH nurse Rita Jacques, who volunteers on Mondays at Street Help and has seen first hand the needs of its guests.

"It's a place of no judgement," she says. "Many have fled abusive or alcoholic home lives. This may have led to them living on the street or in a life of prostitution. Poor choices may have been made but no one is perfect, least of all, me ... and that is why I am reminded of: "There but for the grace of God go I." And, if not myself, then it could easily have been my children."

Street Help also provides its guests with clothing needs, especially for winter, including sleeping bags, backpacks, clothes, shoes, warm waterproof winter boots, coats, hats, mitts, scarves and socks!

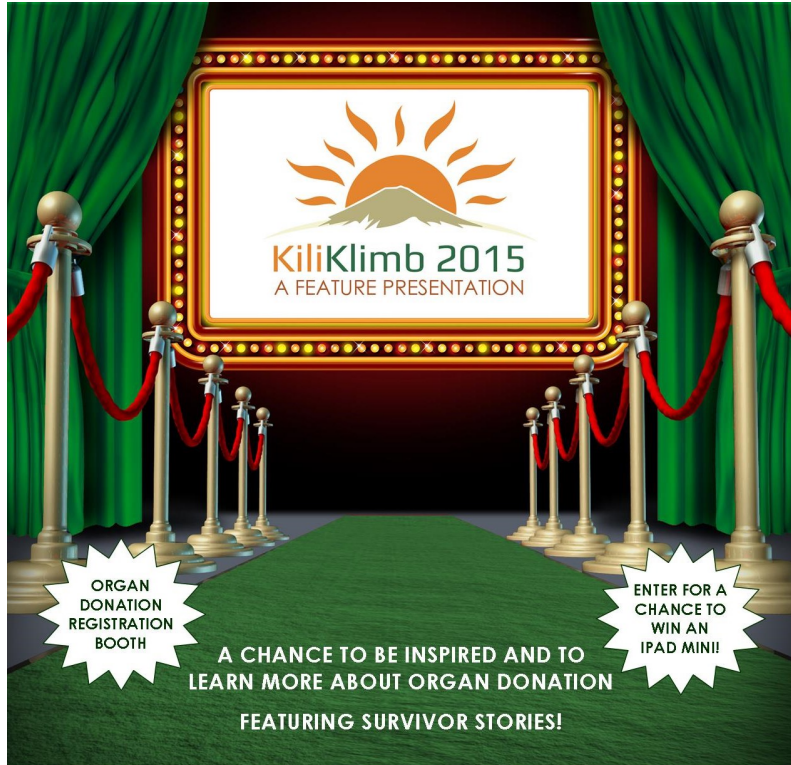
