# Kangaroo Care-A-Thon Nurtures Preemies!

Windsor Regional Hospital launched its 1st Annual Kangaroo Care-A-Thon on May 2, joining over 40 hospitals from around the world participating in the challenge. In partnership with the Canadian Premature Babies Foundation, WRH's Neonatal Intensive Care Unit and Family Birthing Centre began promoting kangaroo care or as it is known, skin-to-skin care, proven to be an integral part of the healthy care of newborn babies, especially premature infants.

Kangaroo Care or skin-to-skin care has proven to improve growth, reduce stress and crying, and assist to facilitate breastfeeding for both baby and mom. Dad too is encouraged to participate in Kangaroo care as it helps both baby and parents enhance their natural bond and strengthens short and long term parent-infant interactions.

Toronto's Sunnbrook Hospital Neonatal Intensive Care Unit is the international organizer of Kangaroo Care, mentoring hospitals like WRH to participate and attempt to beat last year's winners. They include Oregon's Salem Hospital who achieved 2.56 hours of holding baby per day and, Orillia, Ontario's Soldier's Memorial Hospital gaining 3.44 hours of hold per baby per day.

"Each family will receive an information letter, a Kangaroo sticker reminder at their bedside and log sheet to tally their kangaroo cuddle hours." said Heather Ryan, Clinical Practice Coordinator with the NICU. "Also, staff are wearing purple t-shirts to promote the challenge scheduling quiet time on the unit to assist with kangaroo care."

Windsor Regional Hospital's Kangaroo Care-A-Thon runs from May 2 to May 15th, the actual Kangaroo Care Awareness Day!

## Barley Risotto With Brussel Sprouts And Apples

Makes 4 servings Preparation: 20 min Cooking Time: 60 min

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 1 lb brussels sprouts, quartered
- 1 granny smith or honeycrisp apple, peeled and diced
- 1 tsp smoked paprika
- 1 tsp salt
- 5 cups vegetable broth
- 1 cup water
- 1 medium onion, diced
- 1 cup barley
- 2 tbsp champagne honey mustard
- 1/4 cup parmesan cheese
- salt and black pepper, to taste



Preheat oven to 400. Toss brussels sprouts and apple with smoked paprika and salt. Spread on a baking pan. Spray with cooking spray and roast for 20-30 minutes, until caramelized and tender. In the meanwhile, combine the broth and water in a medium pot and bring to a simmer. Spray a large skillet with cooking spray, heating over medium heat. Add the onion to the pan and cook, stirring, until translucent, about 3 minutes. Add the barley and stir for 1 minute. Add the broth to the pan in half cup increments, only adding more when the last batch has almost entirely evaporated, taking care to stir constantly. Do this until most of the broth is gone and the barley is tender, about 40 minutes. Stir in the brussel sprouts and apple. Remove from heat and stir in the mustard and parmesan cheese. Season with salt and pepper to taste. Serve warm.
