Honey Grilled Salmon & Asparagus

Makes 4 servings Preparation: 5 min Cooking Time: 15 min

INGREDIENTS

- 1 tbsp sodium reduced soy sauce
- 2 tsp canola oil
- 2 tsp liquid honey
- 2 tsp packed brown sugar
- 1 tsp chopped fresh thyme or 2 mL (1/2 tsp) dried thyme leaves
- 1/2 tsp fresh ground pepper
- 4 salmon fillets, about 150 g/5 oz each
- 1 bunch fresh asparagus, trimmed
- 1/2 fresh lemon

METHOD

In a small bowl, stir together soy sauce, oil, honey, sugar, thyme and pepper. Place salmon in a shallow dish. Pour marinade over top of salmon, spreading evenly. Cover and refrigerate for 15 to 30 minutes, turning once if possible. Lightly spray asparagus with cooking spray and place on preheated and oiled grill on medium high heat. Grill, turning a couple of times until tender crisp. Add salmon fillets and grill for 5 minutes. Discard marinade. Turn salmon over and grill for about 5 minutes longer or until fish flakes easily when tested*. Serve with asparagus. Squeeze lemon over asparagus just prior to serving. * Use a digital food thermometer to check that salmon has reached an internal temperature of 70°C (158°F).
