Wear a yellow shirt or sweater to support the Suicide Prevention Week campaign led by the Canadian Mental Health Association (CMHA) in collaboration with the Windsor-Essex County Health Unit (WECHU). WRH is proud to be a community partner supporting this important campaign.

"Suicide impacts all of us, by wearing yellow on Wednesday you are recognizing the importance of continuing the great work we do every day to reduce the risk of suicide in our community" says Jonathan Foster, Director - Mental Health and Regional Renal Programs.





Potato Salad with Corn, Tomatoes And Charred Peppers

Makes 6-8 servings Preparation: 30 min Cooking Time: 20 min

INGREDIENTS (Salad)

- 1 each Red and Yellow Pepper

- 1 1/2 lb (750 g) Ontario Red Skin Potatoes (unpeeled), halved (about 4 medium)
- 3 cobs Ontario Sweet Corn, cooked
- 2 medium Ontario Tomatoes, seeded and diced
- 3 Ontario Green Onions, sliced
- 1/4 cup fresh Ontario Coriander, chopped

INGEREDIENTS (Dressing)

- 1/3 cupolive oil
- 2 tbsp red wine vinegar
- 2 cloves Ontario Garlic, minced
- 2 tsp ground cumin
- 1/2 tsp each salt and black pepper

METHOD (Salad)

Broil red and yellow peppers until charred and blackened on all sides, about 20 minutes. Place in metal bowl; cover and let cool. Peel, seed and cut into 1/2-inch (1 cm) pieces. Meanwhile, in large pot of boiling salted water, cook potatoes until tender, about 15 minutes. Drain and let cool enough to handle. Cut into chunks. With sharp knife, cut kernels from corn cobs and place in large bowl. Add potatoes, charred peppers, tomatoes, green onions and coriander.

METHOD (Dressing)

In small bowl, combine oil, vinegar, garlic, cumin, salt and pepper; add to potato mixture and gently toss to coat. Chill before serving.
