



A flag (e.g. electronic notification, chart sticker) should be placed on the chart of any patient who is colonized or infected with an antibiotic resistant organism (ARO), or a contact of an ARO patient, and the status noted for their specific ARO(s) in the medical record. These flags must protect the confidentiality of the patient.

Help Us Create A Community Of Immunity

The influenza season is almost upon us and this year Windsor Regional Hospital is committed to creating a community of immunity with another flu shot campaign. The Employee Health Office will be holding flu clinics during the last week in October (October 24th - 28th at the Met Campus) and the first week in November (October 31st – November 4th at the Ouellette Campus). Flu clinic times and locations are posted on flyers throughout the hospital.

Staff can also receive flu vaccinations at the We Care Pharmacy (Ouellette Campus) on a drop-in basis, Monday through Friday from 9am to 5pm (extension 32181 or 519-255-2181) or at the IDA Pharmacy (Met Campus) located at the corner of Tecumseh and Kildare in the parking lot (519-977-0090) – please call the pharmacies to confirm hours and flu shot availability.

All hospital staff and physicians will be asked to complete the consent/decline form. These forms can be downloaded from the Employee Health intranet webpage and are also available in the Employee Health Office. If you have been immunized elsewhere or are medically exempt from receiving the flu vaccine, please submit your documentation to the Employee Health Office along with your completed consent/decline form. If you are declining immunization for personal reason, please submit this form to the Employee Health Office as soon as you have completed it.

Once again this year, the We Care Pharmacy will be holding two Family & Friends Flu Clinics on Wednesday, November 16th from 5-8pm and Saturday, November 19th from 9am to 1pm. There will be activities for the kids and free pizza. If these days and times are not convenient, feel free to take advantage of your family doctor, participating local pharmacies, or walk-in clinics.

Maple-Braised Apple & Pork

Makes 4 servings Cooking Time: 25 min

INGREDIENTS

- 1 tsp ground sage
- Salt and pepper
- 1 tbsp butter
- 1 lb Boneless Pork Loin or Tenderloin, 1/2 inch slices
- 1 Ontario Cooking Onion, thinly sliced
- 4 Ontario McIntosh Apples, cored and thinly sliced
- 2 tbsp Ontario Maple Syrup
- 1/2 cup chicken or vegetable stock

METHOD

Rub pork slices with sage; season lightly with salt and pepper. In large skillet, melt butter over medium heat. Add seasoned pork slices; cook until lightly browned, about 1 minute per side. Remove from pan and set aside. Add onion to pan; cook for 5 minutes or until softened, reducing heat if needed. Stir in apples; cook for 5 minutes. Stir in maple syrup. Return pork and accumulated juices to skillet. Add stock; cover and simmer, until juices run clear when pork is pierced, about 5 minutes. Transfer pork to platter and keep warm. Increase heat to high; cook apple mixture until liquid becomes syrupy. Spoon over pork and serve immediately.
