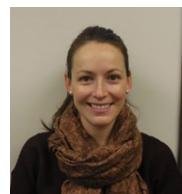

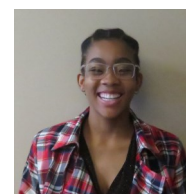

# #RECIPEOFTHEWEEK

## Sheet Pan Chicken & Broccoli Stir Fry

Makes 4 servings / Prep Time: 15 min / Total Time: 35 min

### Sauce:

- 3 tablespoons soy sauce
- 2 tablespoons Chinese cooking wine or dry sherry
- 1 tablespoon grated ginger
- 2 cloves garlic, grated
- 1 tablespoon liquid honey
- 1 tablespoon sesame oil
- 1-1/2 teaspoon cornstarch

- 450g boneless skinless chicken breasts, cut in 1-1/2-inch chunks
- 1 head broccoli, cut in florets and stems peeled, thinly sliced
- 1 large carrot, sliced diagonally
- 1 sweet red pepper, sliced
- 2 cups sugar snap peas, trimmed
- 2 teaspoons each black and white sesame seeds
- cilantro leaves and/or lime wedges (optional)

### Directions

Preheat oven to 425°F. Sauce: In bowl, whisk together soy sauce, cooking wine, ginger, garlic, honey, sesame oil and cornstarch. On baking sheet, toss together chicken, broccoli, carrot, red pepper and Sauce; toss to coat. Arrange in single layer. Bake for 12 minutes; flip chicken and vegetables. Add snap peas; bake until vegetables are tender and chicken is no longer pink inside, 5 to 7 minutes. Sprinkle with sesame seeds and cilantro (if using). Serve with lime wedges (if using).
