- 2 eggs

- 1 cup quick cook oatmeal

- 1/4 cup fresh slivered basil

- 1 teaspoon garlic

Eggplant Parmesan

Makes 6 servings / Total Time: 70 min

INGREDIENTS

- 2 eggplants (6-8 cups)
- 3 tablespoons water
- ¹/₂ cup grated parmesan
- 1/2 tsp ground pepper
- 2 ½ cups tomato sauce
- ¾ cup grated skim mozzarella cheese

DIRECTIONS

Preheat oven to 400 degrees F. Coat two baking sheets and an 8 x 11-1/2-inch baking dish with nonstick cooking spray. Cut eggplants crosswise into ¼ inch-thick slices. Whisk eggs and water in a shallow dish. Combine oatmeal, ¼ cup of parmesan, garlic and pepper in another shallow dish. Dip the eggplant slices into the egg mixture, then coat with the oatmeal mixture (discard any leftover egg or oatmeal mixture). Arrange eggplant slices in a single layer on the prepared baking sheets. Bake for 15 minutes, turn the eggplant slices over, and bake for about 15 minutes longer until crisp and golden. Stir basil into tomato sauce. Spread about 1/2 cup of sauce in the bottom of the prepared baking dish. Arrange half of the eggplant slices over the sauce, overlapping slightly. Spoon 1 cup of the remaining sauce over the eggplant and sprinkle with half of the mozzarella cheese. Add a layer of the remaining eggplant slices and top with the remaining sauce, mozzarella and Parmesan. Bake. uncovered, until the sauce bubbles and the top is golden.
