Karen McKeown is a life-long Windsor resident, currently living the past four years with Stage IV Metastatic Melanoma in her brain, lungs, and left adrenal gland.

Karen credits the dedicated care she received at Windsor Regional Hospital with keeping her alive. And she's experienced first-hand how important updated, high-tech equipment is in fighting cancer like hers.

That's why Karen has decided to share her story with the goal of raising money for the Windsor Regional Hospital Foundation. Karen hopes you will join her and take this opportunity to share your story as well.

Karen is working hard on creating an online legacy book called "Never in a Million Years: A Compilation of Stories from People Living with Life-Altering Diagnoses." Karen says "I think once you are diagnosed with one of these diseases you think 'never in a million years did I think this would be me.'"

Sales of the online book will all directly go towards a piece of equipment Karen is passionate about supporting - the new CT Scan that the hospital recently acquired.

"When I originally went for my CT Scan they had an old machine. When I walked into the room about a month ago, I immediately noticed the CT Scan was new. This one is three times as effective. If you're well, you don't think about health needs. When you're ill, you realize that these new technologies are so necessary. You never know when you're going to need that type of diagnostic imaging. It helps doctors know what they're dealing with – and how to treat you."

LADDER SAFETY

IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

- Inspect for damage, wear, broken parts, grease/ice
- Place only on firm, level, nonslip surface (slip resistant feet)
- Ensure spreaders are locked





SAFE WORK PRACTICES:

- Ensure area beneath is free of obstructions or clutter
- Wear clean, appropriate footwear
- Face the ladder keep centered between the side rails
- Maintain three (3) points of contact at all times (hands/feet)
- Avoid over-reaching or leaning too far over top
- Never use top level as a step or seat and avoid using top two rungs
- Never place ladder on unstable surfaces or items such as boxes, pails, chairs, benches, stairs, planks, or other ladders
- Use a spotter/fall protection if higher than 3 metres (10 feet)

- 1 cup chopped onion

- 3 tbsp all-purpose flour

- 2 cups homogenized milk

- 1 tbsp chopped fresh sage

Turkey & Sage Ricotta Cannelloni

Makes 6 servings

Prep Time: 25 min / Total Time: 1 hr

INGREDIENTS

- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 2 cloves of garlic, minced
- 2 cups chopped cooked turkey 1 cup ricotta cheese
- 3 tbsp unsalted butter
- 1/2 tsp nutmeg
- 3/4 cups grated Parmesan cheese, divided - 4 slices bacon, cooked and crumbled
- 5 ready-to-cook fresh lasagna sheets, halved lengthwise
- 1 cup shredded mozzarella cheese, divided

DIRECTIONS

In saucepan, heat oil over medium heat; cook onion until tender, about 3 minutes. Add garlic and sage; cook for 2 minutes. Let cool. Transfer to bowl; mix in turkey, ricotta, 1/4 cup Parmesan, and bacon. On work surface, divide turkey mixture among lasagna sheets; roll up to make cannelloni. Set aside. Place butter in microwave-safe bowl; microwave until melted, 20 to 30 seconds. Whisk in flour and nutmeg; slowly pour in milk, whisking constantly. Microwave for 3 minutes, whisking every minute. Mix in 1/4 cup Parmesan and half of the mozzarella. Preheat oven to 375°F. Spread 1/4 cup of the béchamel sauce over bottom of 11- x 7-inch baking dish. Arrange cannelloni over top; spoon remaining sauce over top. Sprinkle remaining Parmesan and mozzarella over top. Bake until filling is hot and cheese is browned, about 25 minutes.
