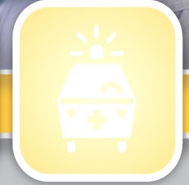

Realignment of Services Effective October 1, 2013!

The Board of Hôtel-Dieu Grace Hospital (HDGH) and the Board of Windsor Regional Hospital (WRH) have approved the transitional realignment plan for the Windsor hospitals. Effective **October 1, 2013**, WRH will be responsible for the governance and management of the programs and services at the Metropolitan and Ouellette Campuses. HDGH will be responsible for the governance and management of the programs and services at the Tayfour campus and those off-site programs associated with the Tayfour Campus. The exception is the Crisis Program that will continue to be governed and managed by HDGH.
