Construction of the original Hospital on Ouellette Avenue in Windsor began October 10, 1888. The 1888 building was of Norman style architecture with three turrets and the total cost was approximately \$40,000.00.

The three-story brick building had a capacity of 100 beds. It was demolished in 1963.
