Parking at the Met Campus

Recently, there has been an increase in the number of staff members parking their vehicles in the Met Campus staff lot without consideration for the other vehicles and staff members parked there. We have asked in the past that staff be courteous and considerate of the other people who are parking in the lot. Specifically, we have indicated that staff must not park in a way that obstructs the flow of traffic into and out of the parking lot. Any vehicle parked in a way that obstructs traffic from entering/exiting the staff parking lot will be towed. The expense for the towing will be charged to the employee. In addition, the Hospital will revoke parking privileges for any staff member found to be parked in an obstructing fashion.

At Met there are designated parking areas for patients/visitors seeking Emergency Services and for patients/visitors who are pregnant/accompanied by small children. Staff members are using these spaces with alarming frequency. These spaces are not for use by staff members. Any staff vehicles found parked in these spaces will be ticketed and/or towed. Any expense for towing related to being parked in prohibited areas will be charged to the employee. In addition to ticketing/towing, any staff member that is found parked in these areas will have any existing parking privileges revoked.
