# Zero Based Budgeting

Windsor Regional Hospital is moving forward on Phase II of the Zero Based Budgeting (ZBB) process. ZBB is a technique for building budgets from the "bottom up" rather than the "top down". It focuses on rethinking approaches to service delivery to eliminate unnecessary activity, restructure inefficient processes, better balance workload and staffing and reduce costs. It is meant to engage all staff in the reexamination of service delivery. ZBB provides a means for allocating resources to achieve our mission of providing 'exceptional care with compassion'. The seven initiatives that will be the focus of Phase II are: 1. Inpatient/Outpatient Programming for Rehabilitation 2. Operating Room and Ambulatory Care Clinic Activities 3. Supply and Expense Reductions 4. Medical /Surgical Supply Expense Reductions 5. Acute Care Staff/Patient Ratios 6. Complex Continuing Care Staff/Patient Ratios/Staffing Mix and Cohorting Patients and 7. Development of a Comprehensive Urology Program. Stay tuned for ZBB updates.
