The Adult Day Program is located in the Malden Park Facility on the first floor. The clients come in from their homes to share a day away. The program gives respite to family members and provides social and recreational activities for clients. The program is available Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm each day. Clients served at the Adult Day Programs are 55 years of age and older with mild to moderate dementia, physically handicapped, chronically ill and or frail and they have the capacity and willingness to participate in the program with supportive care. Clients bring in their own lunch, provide their own transportation and are charged a nominal fee.
