Western Campus Update

There are changes for access and parking taking place at the **Western Campus**. The roadway through the campus will be closed temporarily. WRH staff parking and Visitor access to Malden Park during this time shall use the temporary parking booth for access at the South end of the campus in Parking Lot D—opposite the Glengarda building at Connaught & Chappell. The existing parking booth at Prince Road will still be in operation for visitors. During the day shift Parking Lots A, B1 & B2 will be designated for patient/visitor parking only. Visitors/Staff will have shared access to Parking Lot F across from the CPH building. This is a short term closure/redirection during which the Tower Main Entrance will still be available. When this work is complete, patients/visitors/staff will have access to approximately eighty (80) new parking spaces along the West side of the campus. The end date is anticipated to be October 30th, 2009.
