Did you know?

According to Canada's Chief Public Health Officer, David Butler-Jones, the risk of experiencing severe side effects after receiving the H1N1 vaccine is one in a million, compared with the 20 to 35 per cent of the population who will get sick from this pandemic flu without protection. "If every single Canadian is inoculated," he said, "then 30 Canadians could have the potential for a severe side effect, compared to 10 million people sick, 100,000 people in hospital and 10,000 people dead."
