Chatham-Kent Health Alliance (CKHA) and Windsor Regional Hospital (WRH) are implementing a new electronic pharmacy system called Horizon Meds Manager (HMM). HMM is a computerized pharmacy solution that improves workflow and ensures patient safety. It allows the pharmacy to electronically receive, verify and send medication orders, eliminating manual transcription and preventing medication errors. The innovative solution captures medication use across care settings and disciplines, linking all patient encounters in a real-time electronic chart.
