# Flexible Sigmoidoscopy

Windsor Regional Hospital is pleased to announce that an additional Cancer Screening option is available to Health Care Providers in the Erie St. Clair LHIN. Flexible Sigmoidoscopy detects 60% of Cancers and polyps (vs. FOBT which detects 25%) and can be done safely in office settings. Nurses, under the supervision of a Gastroenterologist/Surgeon will perform the test in the Endoscopy Suite.
