Western Redevelopment on Time and on Budget

The Honourable Sandra Pupatello, MPP for Windsor West and Minister of Economic Development and Trade, joined Windsor Regional Hospital officials for a construction update and tour of the hospital's new longer-term mental health building. Construction of the Windsor Regional Hospital addition began in June 2009 and is on track to open its doors to patients in spring 2012. Bondfield Construction is building the new facility. Construction of the new longer-term mental health building is now 50 per cent complete and is proceeding on time and on budget. Construction crews will complete the building's exterior cladding in the fall of this year and work will continue on mechanical and electrical installations and interior finishes during the coming months. Interior and exterior renovations to the hospital's Tower Building will begin early in 2011.
