With the transition of long term care residents from Malden Park to the community, Windsor Regional Hospital successfully relocated 50 Rehabilitation patients and 99 Complex Continuing Care patients from the Tower Building at the Western Campus to the Malden Park building. This is to ready the Tower Building for complete construction renovation over the next 18 months. The majority of patient moves were made through the tunnel between the main Tower Building and the Malden Park facility with the assistance of staff and over 300 nursing students from the University of Windsor.
