On January 1, 2012, Ontario hospitals will become subject to the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (FIPPA). FIPPA was extended to cover hospitals as a result of the *Broader Public Sector Accountability Act, 2010*, which received Royal Assent on December 10, 2010.
