Problem Gambling Services remains the sole gambling-only residential treatment program in the Province. On May 27, 2012 we will be welcoming our 100<sup>th</sup> Residential Treatment group! PGS has helped over 550 people from across Ontario. The staff at PGS are proud of this accomplishment and of being such a big part of helping people change their lives for the better!
