“Tower” is now the Fouad Tayfour Rehabilitation Centre

Dr. Fouad Tayfour and Lisa Tayfour officially opened and dedicated the new **Fouad Tayfour Regional Rehabilitation Centre** (Tower Building) as part of the named recognition and significant donation made to the *Cornerstone of Caring* campaign. The enhanced 60-bed Regional Rehabilitation Centre will provide comprehensive, interdisciplinary rehabilitation for adults suffering from strokes, amputations, head injuries, spinal cord injuries, multiple sclerosis and orthopaedic injuries such as hip replacements and fractures. A key feature is the highly skilled interdisciplinary team offering Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy treatment on the same floor as the bedded areas, giving the team an opportunity to monitor their patients more closely through their therapy. I am honoured to have this facility named on my behalf as I think it is very important to give back to the community to enhance patient care," stated Dr. Tayfour. The campaign began in 2009 and is approaching its goal of \$7.5 million to redevelop the entire Tayfour Campus (formerly Western Campus). Bondfield Construction, Infrastructure Ontario and Windsor Regional Hospital partnered to see a new Mental Health and Rehabilitation facility built, along with improvements to Complex Continuing Care and the development of a Healing Garden.
