WRH Delivers Quadruplets

Windsor Regional Hospital delivered its first set of Quadruplets (that is four babies) recently. The three boys Ahmed, Mohammed and Mohanad and their sister Dana each weighed between 2 lbs. 10 oz. and 4 lbs. 1 oz. The four small infants are in good condition in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) at the Met Campus undergoing close observation. The Ontario government is currently conducting a review of Ontario's 14 NICUs.

Effective Aug 1, 2012 Windsor Regional Hospital has entered into a new contract to provide shuttle services for employees. The new company that will be providing the service is **Voyageur Transportation Services** (Voyageur). Voyageur is an integrated logistics and transportation company. They provide a full spectrum of professional services including a *Checker Limousine* sedan service; school busing, charter and shuttle services; freight delivery and specialized medical services – such as non-emergency patient transfers. The service provided to staff will remain unchanged; however, please be patient as we make this transition. New buses are planned to be in service in late August.

Windsor Regional Hospital has delivered 7,106 newborns over the last two years (2010/2011 and 2011/2012 fiscal years). Of those, 5 sets were triplets and 125 sets were twins.
