## **Regional Data Centre Relocation Project to Launch**

This fall, servers housed at CKHA and WRH will be moved from on-site to an off-site location. This relocation will require a downtime of many applications while the servers are moved to the Regional Data Centre. It will be necessary for staff at both sites to use downtime procedures during this outage. The outage window will be planned outside of regular business hours, and will impact clinical areas. Additionally, to prepare for this move, hardware upgrades, application upgrades and server hardware replacements are ongoing with short downtime outages. These are being communicated to sites to ensure the equipment has support and also to mitigate risks associated with older equipment. The CHIS Team, working with IBM has just completed the "Assessment and Discovery Phase" and will move into the next phase of work, "Transition Plan Phase" which includes setting the dates for the move, outage time, planning the physical move and clearly identifying what applications are impacted.
