CHIS and PROcure began utilizing the new Service Desk System on Monday, July 23, 2012. The software provides confirmation that a service request has been made and that work is being undertaken to respond to the request as quickly as possible. The self-service component has now been launched at Windsor Regional Hospital. Staff can now enter work requests through this portal, browse the request catalogue of common service requests (password resets, move computers, order equipment just to name a few) and also have the means to easily check on the status of request tickets and receive regular updates.
