Workwell Audit

As a result of a Workwell Health and Safety Audit held at Windsor Regional Hospital (WRH) from September 17 to the 19, 2012, by the Workplace Safety & Insurance Board (WSIB) Prevention Services Branch, WRH has passed with a positive score of **85.3%**. An outstanding score of 840 was achieved out of a possible 985. The representative conducting the audit stated that the score indicates that a formalized Health and Safety program exists in our organization. All staff are to be complimented for the positive actions taken to assist with preventing workplace injuries and illness.

Breast Health

As of November 5, 2012, breast screening that has been provided in the past at the Ontario Breast Screening Program (OBSP) site on Walker Road will be provided in the Breast Health Centre at Windsor Regional Hospital - Met Campus. The Walker Road site will be closing. *Only the location of care will change* - the organization and high quality standards of OBSP will remain the same and the hallmark services of OBSP will continue. The newly designed program will provide greater access to screening for breast, colorectal and cervical cancers.
