Telemedicine is the delivery of clinical care, professional or patient education or meetings using two-way videoconferencing and diagnostic instruments such as digital stethoscopes, otoscopes and patient exam cameras. The Telemedicine team currently consists of three Telemedicine nurses; Jennifer Jovanovski for Children's Mental Health, April Reed for Chronic Disease and Lee Sippel for the Cancer Program.
