# May is Sexual Assault Awareness Month

Across Canada, May is **Sexual Assault Awareness Month**. According to a 2006 Statistics Canada report, one in three women will experience some form of sexual assault in their lifetime. In 2008, Statistics Canada reported that over half (59%) of the police-reported sexual assault victims were under the age of 18; 81% of young victims were female and 19% were male. The Sexual Assault/Domestic Violence Treatment Center (SA/DVTC) for Windsor and Essex County is located at the Metropolitan Campus. It is easily accessed through the Emergency Departments. Specially trained Response Team Nurses or Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Services are available to all victims of sexual assault regardless of age or gender.

### **Ovarian Cancer Day**

Recently, ovarian cancer organizations from around the world united to educate their communities about ovarian cancer and its symptoms. For women living with the disease, and their families and friends, World Ovarian Cancer Day builds a sense of solidarity in the fight against the disease. Ovarian cancer is diagnosed annually in more than 220,000 women, and is responsible for 140,000 deaths each year. Statistics show that just 45% of women with ovarian cancer are likely to survive for five years compared to up to 89% of women with breast cancer.
