New Name for Malden Park

Windsor Regional Hospital is pleased to announce, as part of the successful Western Redevelopment Project and *Cornerstone of Caring* campaign, that the Malden Park facility at the Tayfour Campus has been renamed the **Dr. Y. Emara Centre for Healthy Aging and Mobility**. Malden Park Continuing Care Centre opened in 1995 as a long term care facility when residents in the former Riverview Hospital transferred to this new facility. It continued as a long term facility until 2011. It is now defined as a continuing care facility with up to 196 beds and will focus on maximizing the mobility and functioning of individual patients. One of the features is a Palliative Care Unit, currently being transformed by a generous donation from *Transition to Betterness* into a Supportive Care Unit. The facility is named after the father of Dr. Barry Emara, local Eye Physician and Surgeon. Dr. Y Emara was a Professor of Botany and died tragically in an accident in 2004.
