MEGA-HOSPITAL HIGHLIGHTS

Hotel-Dieu Grace Healthcare (Tayfour Campus on Prince Road)



- 60-beds coming from Ouellette campus for acute mental health wing
- Addition of dialysis services and expansion of diagnostic imaging

Windsor Regional Hospital Urgent Care Centre (former Grace hospital site)

- Construction of four-storey, 80,022-square-foot building for treatment of non-life threatening issues
- Diagnostic services (CT scanner), chronic disease management, laboratory services and pharmacy
- Open 18 hours per day

Hotel-Dieu Grace Healthcare (Ouellette Campus)

- Outpatient mental health services and chronic disease management
- Construction of Transitional Stability Centre and Wellness Centre
- Demolition of existing buildings except for parking garage

Windsor Regional Hospital (Metropolitan Campus)

- City of Windsor assumes ownership of site
- Demolition of existing buildings and site cleanup
- Re-development of site for residential and or commercial use

Windsor Regional Hospital (Mega-Hospital site)

- Construction of a 1.6-million-square-foot, 10-storey hospital at eastern corner of County Road 42 and Ninth Concession
- All existing services will be available
- Hospital will have 500 beds at opening with capacity to increase for projected needs
- Helipad
