

Tell your nurse right away if you start to feel unwell or are experiencing any reactions while in the clinic. The nurse may need to stop the infusion.

After the infusion, give yourself time to see how the medicine affects you. Avoid driving or operating a machine until you feel you are able and alert.

A SERIOUS side effect is an allergic reaction,

- Trouble breathing
- Feeling light-headed or dizzy
- Severe nausea, vomiting, or belly pain
- Chest pain
- Swelling of your throat, face, mouth, tongue, legs, or hands
- Low blood pressure

Get immediate medical help if you experience any of the following symptoms of an allergic reaction:

- Difficulty breathing
- Low blood pressure
- Swelling of your face, tongue, or throat
- Severe abdominal pain, nausea, or vomiting
- Chest pain
- Severe rash or hives
