Yellow Belt Training in Action

As part of completing their Yellow Belt certification this, group of candidates participated in a Kaizen (Rapid Improvement Event). The participants were divided into 2 different working groups. The first group worked on the feasibility of a "Pharmacy First Fill" prior to discharging patients who had undergone a Percutaneous Catheter Intervention. The second group worked on "Order Set Supply in the Emergency Department, at the Met campus".

"Everyone was very engaged by using the Lean tools and helped the team stay focused making the event run smoothly," said Antoinette Duronio, Clinical Pharmacy Manager and lead for the Pharmacy First Fill process improvement team.
