
During a "mental comfort" round conducted every two hours or more, a nurse would ask their patient about their Mood, Thoughts, At Risk Behaviour, Interventions, and Room Safety. This deliberate round promotes therapeutic conversation allowing the patient to be involved in their care and allows the nurse to proactively identify behavioural changes. We look forward to hearing about the success of this bundle as it is implemented in the following weeks and thank the frontline staff for their ongoing feedback and contributions!

Knee Arthroscopy: Preparing to launch the first outpatient procedure

As part of the Quality Based Procedures (QBP) Pathways Improvement Program, patients preparing and recovering from a Knee Arthroscopy procedure will soon benefit from standardize care practices and patient education. Over the last few months, teams from the Pre-assessment, Day Surgery and Operative Rooms worked together to develop Order Sets, Clinical Pathways, and the My Care Journey brochure and mobile app.

Patients will receive the brochure and information about the app from their surgeon. The standardized care will continue during their pre-assessment visit, surgery, and recovery at home.
