Reaching out to staff and physicians for the next wave of QBP Order Sets

The next wave of diagnoses for the QBP Pathway Improvement Program includes Hemorrhagic Stroke and elective Hip and Knee Replacements. QBP teams have been working over the last few weeks to review existing Order Sets and discuss best practices. Using provincial best practice guidelines and other international best practices, the cross-functional teams have created the first draft of new Order Sets.

Team members will be reaching out to front-line staff this week and next week to gather feedback. If you are involved in the care of stroke patients or patients having had elective hip and knee replacements, please ask your manager for copies of the new Order Sets. Your feedback is important!
