Med Fluid and End of shift checks

The Med fluid project team is trying to standardize end of shift checks to prevent the potential for missed orders. During a mapping session this summer, we learned end of shift checks are already an essential part of a nurses' job, however, there is a no standard process in place to prevent missed orders. The 8th Floor Neurology floor staff will be working with the Med Fluid team on a pilot project to test a new shift check protocol, to see if we can improve this process and then expand it to other units. This week the teams will work with the Neurology floor staff to ensure they have the support and understanding needed to kick off the End of Shift process pilot!

ICU Mapping Event

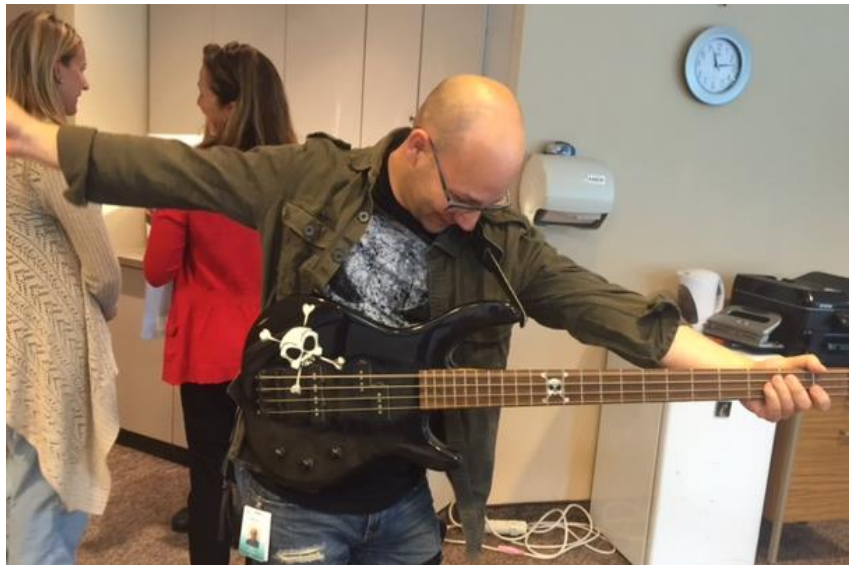
The ICU group will be working on mapping out the process for patients coming into the ICU from the Emergency Department on October 8, 2015. In this mapping session we are trying to better understand the delays in getting these critical patients from the ED up to the ICU. This process is directly related to our main outcome measure of "Time from ED admission decision to ICU Bed" for which we have a target of 90min. This is a provincial mandated target.
