
Community Palliative Medicine Program

- Referral Criteria
 - Progressive Life-limiting diagnosis
 - Expected prognosis three months or less
- NOTE:
 - Not appropriate for chronic, non-malignant pain management
 - Not intended to replace primary care
- Referrals triaged by our Palliative Care Coordinator
 - Urgent referrals need to be discussed with Palliative Care Coordinator





• Windsor Campus – 10 beds



• Erie Shores – 10 beds









- No cost to patients or families
- Physician coverage by Palliative Care Specialists
- 24 hours of Nursing and PSW support
- Social Work
- Spiritual Care
- Volunteers









- Eligibility Criteria
 - Prognosis <3 months</p>
 - Completed DNR-C
- Considerations for Admission
 - PPS ≤50%
 - No plans for further chemotherapy, blood transfusions
 - Radiation and other procedures can be considered for symptom management
 - Imaging and Labwork not performed routinely but can be considered

- Applications initiated by LHIN Care Coordinators
- Bed offers made based on priority of need
 - No need to apply early to "get on the list"
 - Coordinators at all Palliative Placement Facilities ensure those who require beds have access




