Patient & Family Advisors (PFA) will provide input to assist us in making lasting impact improvements for patients with cancer and their caregivers across the Erie St. Clair Region in the areas of prevention, screening, diagnosis, treatment, survivorship, palliative and end-of-life care.

PFAs are able to determine their level of involvement with initiatives based on their interests. There will be various sub-committees that PFAs are able to join. These sub-committees meet on an ad hoc basis until the completion of the initiative. To acknowledge the significant partnership between the cancer program and patients/family/caregivers, meetings and outcomes are guided by both Patient & Family Advisory Council members and Cancer Program staff.

Advisors are asked to:

- Provide input and recommendations to improve cancer programs and services across the Erie St. Clair Region on an ad hoc basis;
- Join any sub-committees based on interests. Videoconferencing and/or teleconferencing is available for those unable to attend in person;
- Be a past patient with cancer, family member or caregiver;
- Reside within the Chatham-Kent, Sarnia/Lambton and Windsor/Essex area;
- Have access to email and the internet.

This is a volunteer position; travel costs are covered, and refreshments may be provided at meetings.
