Medical Students Partner with SOP on the Quality Improvement Journey

Recently, three student groups from the Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry gave their mid-term presentations on their Quality Improvement projects. They have been working with the SOP team over the past few months on the following projects:

1. Effectiveness of silver dressing and chlorhexidine sponge use on prevention of ortho hip/knee surgical site Infections and associated readmissions
2. Impact of physician led daily patient care rounds
3. Determining best practices and potential gap analysis for Pressure Injury prevention



In depth and comprehensive literature reviews were shared along with preliminary data, observations and plans for further analysis. One project will be selected to advance and develop a poster presentation for a regional conference.

We are looking forward to their final analysis and presentations!
