Corporate Renaming and Rebranding off to Strong Start

Windsor Regional Hospital (WRH) continues to advance work on the new hospital, with Phase One construction, the Enabling Works including an Education and Administration Centre and parking garage, expected to begin early in the new year. To align with the modern facility and the organization's evolving role in the community, WRH is refreshing its corporate name and visual identity.

In September, WRH launched a renaming and rebranding engagement initiative, inviting all staff, professional staff, patients and community members to complete a survey and have their say. Within the first week, more than 1000 participants have provided their input.

The survey will remain open until December 15, 2025. It is currently available in French and English, with additional translations coming soon.

Paper copies of the online surveys are also available through the hospital's redevelopment office.

This is a common step many large healthcare organizations have undergone as part of major redevelopment projects to ensure their identity reflects their facilities, services, and role they play in the community.

Over the coming months, the WRH team will also engage directly with community members and groups to gather feedback. Direct engagement opportunities are already taking place - a couple of which are highlighted below. Future in-person opportunities will be published on the project website, shared through the hospital's social media channels and by email with those subscribed to the project email list.

The Fancsy Family Hospital is on the Map

The future Fancsy Family Hospital now has an official address at 6215 Cabana Rd. East. (formerly County Rd. 42). The address was determined as part of site planning requirements. In addition, the future Education and Administration Building – part of the Phase 1 Enabling Works Project – will have its own address at 6015.

This milestone opens the door for important next steps, including:

- allowing construction teams, contractors and suppliers to formally reference the site,
- providing required material for municipal approvals, utility connections, and emergency services planning, and
- setting the stage for mail, deliveries, and digital mapping systems (Google Maps, GPS, etc.).
