WRH to install new PET/CT Scanner at Cancer Centre

WINDSOR, ON. A new PET/CT Scanner that will provide state-of-the-art diagnostics for cancer patients will be installed this Friday.

The 53-foot long, 8-foot wide structure containing the scanner, weighing 68,000 pounds altogether, will be backed into its new home at the south side of Met Campus adjacent to the Cancer Centre. It will be delivered on a 53-foot trailer. Neighbours have already been notified about potential temporary disruptions, particularly along Alsace Ave., during the installation process, which is expected to take about four hours.
